As a player during a session time at Launceston Tennis Club you are expected to abide by the following code of practice:

- All players must play within the rules and respect officials and their decisions.
- All players must respect the rights, dignity and worth of all participants regardless of age, gender, ability, race, cultural background, religious beliefs or sexual identity.
- Players should keep to agreed timings for training and competitions, or inform their coach or team manager if they are going to be late.
- Players must wear suitable footwear and clothing for training sessions, and the session leader has the authority to disallow play if they feel there is an health and safety risk..
- Players must pay any fees for training or events promptly.
- Players are not allowed to smoke on club premises or whilst representing the club at competitions.
- Junior players are not allowed to consume alcohol or drugs of any kind on the club premises or whilst representing the club.
